

Downloading and eBooks to the Sony Reader Wi-Fi

Note: If you have a Sony Reader Wi-Fi, the eBook checkout procedure can be done entirely on your device.

1. On the second screen of your device (click the > arrow in the bottom right hand corner of your device) , click the button labeled “public library”.
2. On the new screen that appears you will have the option to “find a library” or “browse for libraries”. There will also be a list of libraries at the bottom that you have previously clicked on. Type your zip code into the box under “find a library” and click “go”.
3. A list of libraries in the area will appear; click on one of the Chemung County Library District Libraries (Steele, Horseheads, Big Flats, West, or Van Etten), then click on “Southern Tier Library System” on the following screen.
4. You should now be on the Overdrive site where you can search or browse for books. Select an eBook for checkout (**select EPUB or PDF only**).
5. Click “Borrow” (if the item is checked out you can click “Place a Hold”; you will get an email when the hold is available).
6. Log into your account by selecting “Southern Tier Library System” from the drop menu and typing in your library card number (13 digit number on the back of your card) and PIN (last four digits of your phone number).
7. Click “Download” and then select either EPUB or PDF (EPUB is the preferred format, if available).
8. Click “Confirm & Download”
9. At the top of your device you will see “Downloading...”. You can click on this and drag your finger down if you’d like to open the download window to see the progress.

10. Once the download has completed, click the home button on your device (it looks like a house). You will see your downloaded title on the home screen of your device in the “recently added” section (it might take a few seconds to appear, after the download has completed).
