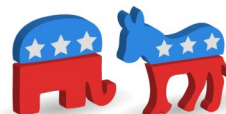

Walk Off the Pounds

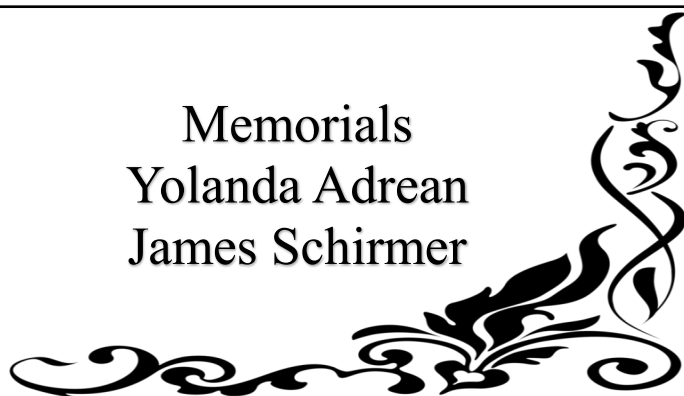
Come and join us on Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 9am for our indoor walking program!! We "Walk Off the Pounds" with Leslie Sansone videos.
