We appreciate your cooperation and understanding.


A gentle reminder from the Director: We are very proud of our vast DVD collection and know that this is a great service to so many. Several years ago DVDs were checked out for 3 days and the maximum you could check out was 3. Times have changed! We now let patrons take out 7 DVDs for 7 days and allow ONE renewal.

We had to limit the number of TV series that could be checked out as we found it was impossible for a patron to watch an entire series within the checkout period and we prefer not to break up a series. We now limit the check out of TV series to 3 per check out.

However, we still find that patrons are requesting extensions on the checkout period beyond the two weeks. This is not fair to other patrons. We can suggest taking out less DVDs at a time to ensure that you can watch them all OR return DVDs when they are due and check them out again at another time. Patrons are often waiting for the return.

So, basically, try not to take out more DVDs than you can handle in the one to two week period.




Buy a Bestseller Program
