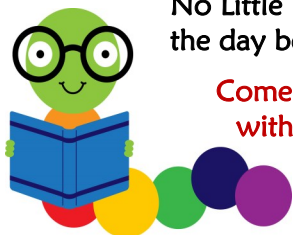

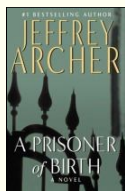

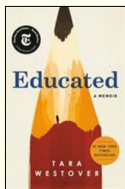
Hammondspoint Book Discussion Group

on the following **Mondays at 6:45 pm.**



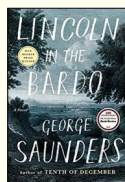
November 18, 2019
