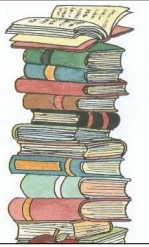

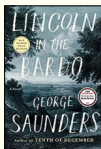

Hammondsport Book Discussion Group

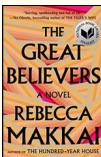
The library book discussion group meets

January 13, 2020 • *Lincoln at the Bardo*, by George Saunders — A story of familial love and loss that breaks free of its realistic, historical framework into a supernatural realm both hilarious and terrifying.



February 10, 2020 • *The Lager Queen of Minnesota*, by J. Ryan Stradal — A generational story of family, all in the context of a passion for brewing beer as told through the small-town Midwestern lives of three stout women who survive, strive & remarkably reinvent themselves.



March 9, 2020 • *Great Believers*, by Rebecca Makkai
A multiple awards winning novel of friendship and redemption in the face of tragedy and loss set in 1980s Chicago and contemporary Paris and about what it's like to live during times of crisis.



April 13, 2020 • *Once and Future King*, by T.H. White
