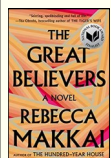

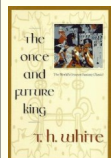

March 9, 2020 • *The Great Believers*, by Rebecca Makkai—A multiple awards winning novel of friendship and redemption in the face of tragedy and loss set in 1980s Chicago and contemporary Paris and about what it's like to live during times of crisis.



April 13, 2020 • *The Once and Future King*, by T.H. White—A masterful retelling of the saga of King Arthur. Once upon a time, a young boy called Wart was tutored by a magician named Merlyn in preparation for a future he couldn't possibly imagine.



May 11, 2020 • *Mansfield Park*, by Jane Austen Taken from the poverty of her parents' home at age 10, Fanny Price is brought up with her rich cousins at Mansfield Park, acutely aware of her humble rank and with her cousin Edmund as her sole ally.



June 8, 2020 • *Becoming*, by Michelle Obama In her memoir, Michelle Obama chronicles the experiences that have shaped her—from her childhood on the South Side of Chicago to her years as an executive balancing the demands of motherhood and work, to her time spent at the world's most famous address.
