Meeting Called to Order: President Tompkins opened the meeting at 6:03 P.M

Minutes Approval: Trustee Fabre made, and Trustee Kellogg seconded, a motion to accept the April minutes. All approved.

Director Murphy's Report:

Director Murphy was excited to share that we will be hosting the STLS library directors retreat at the end of June and that the Community Report has been finalized and sent out. She also reminded the board of the Town of Urbana time capsule and to let her know if anyone would like to add items.

Buildings & Grounds Report:

The Katherine Meade Memorial Tribute landscaping project is underway. Trustee Watson has agreed to take over Buildings and Grounds.

Trustee Curran reported that there has been no new activity for April.
