"If you are looking for services or supports, or would like to learn more about Alzheimer's Disease, stop in and speak with us." No appointment is necessary.

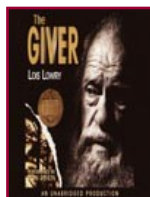

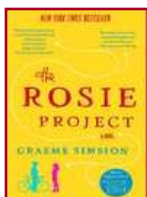
