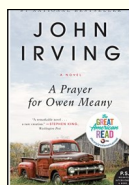

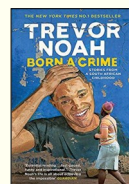
## Hammondsport Book Discussion Group

The library book discussion group meets at the Fred & Harriett Taylor Memorial Library on the following Mondays at 6:45 pm.



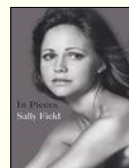
May 13, 2019

A modern classic and parable.



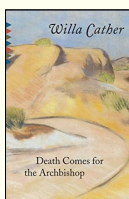
June 10, 2019
