on the following **Mondays at 6:45 pm.**



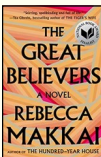
**December 9, 2019 • *Educated***, by Tara Westover —

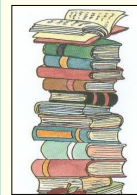
