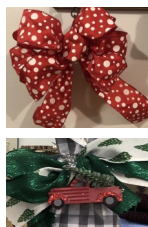

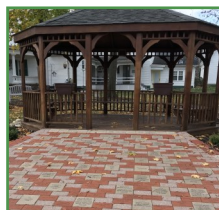

Kids and teens (ages 10-18) are invited to **drop in** for light snacks and open crafts. *The special project is button making.*

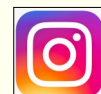
Buy a Memorial Brick through February 28

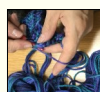
