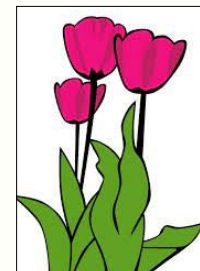

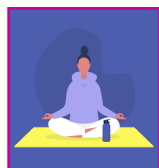

Fee due at the class. *Maximum of 30 participants.*

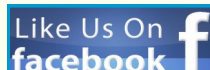
